Journal/Book Cover

YOU WILL NEED:

Fabric: 3/4 yard 45" or 60" wide

A. Cut two 11" x 18 1/2" pieces from your fabric for the BACK and BACK LINING

B. Cut two 11 x 12 3/4" pieces from your fabric for the FRONT

Fusible Fleece Remnant: Cut one 18 1/2" x 11" piece

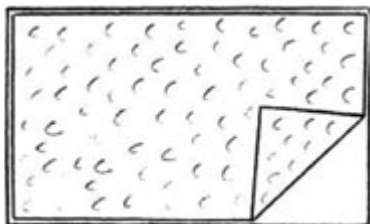
Thread

Ribbon: 1 1/8 yard of 1" wide

Flexible Braid: 1 1/8 yard of 1/2" wide

INSTRUCTIONS:

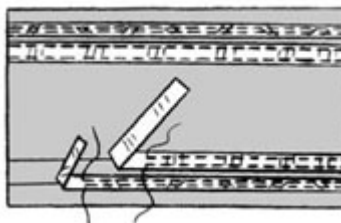
1. Fuse Fleece remnant to wrong side of one 11" x 18 1/2" BACK section, following manufacturer's instructions. Remaining back section will be used as lining.



2. On the right side of one BACK, mark 1 1/4" down from top edge; this will be your placement line for flexible braid. Then mark 2 1/4" down from the top edge; this will be your placement line for ribbon. Do the same for bottom edge, measuring up 1 1/4", then measuring up 2 1/4".

3. Center flexible braid over upper and lower placement lines on back; stitch in place.

4. Center ribbon over remaining placement lines on back; stitch close to long edges.



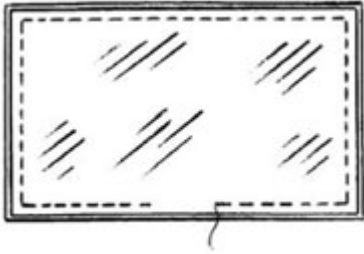
5. With wrong sides together, fold each FRONT section vertically down the center; press. Baste.



6. With right sides together, pin front sections to back, as shown. Baste raw edges together.

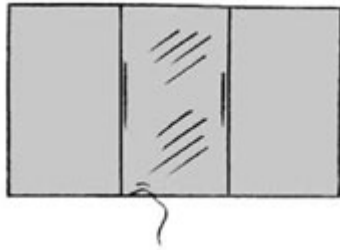


7. With right sides together, stitch back lining and back together, leaving an opening on lower edge between front sections.



8. Turn right side out, turning in remaining seam allowance; press. slipstitch opening.

9. Slip book cover over front sections of journal cover.



Finished Measurement:

7 1/2" x 9 1/2" x 1 1/2"
