### Memory Board

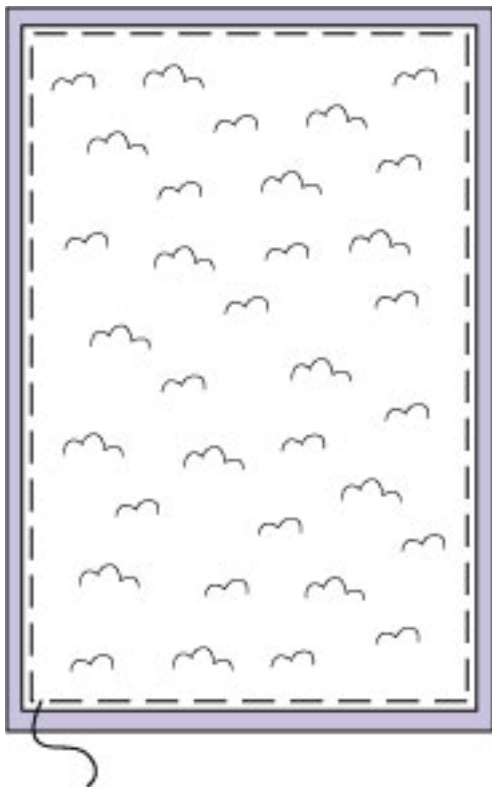
**YOU WILL NEED:**

**FABRIC:** One 26" x 36" piece of fabric.

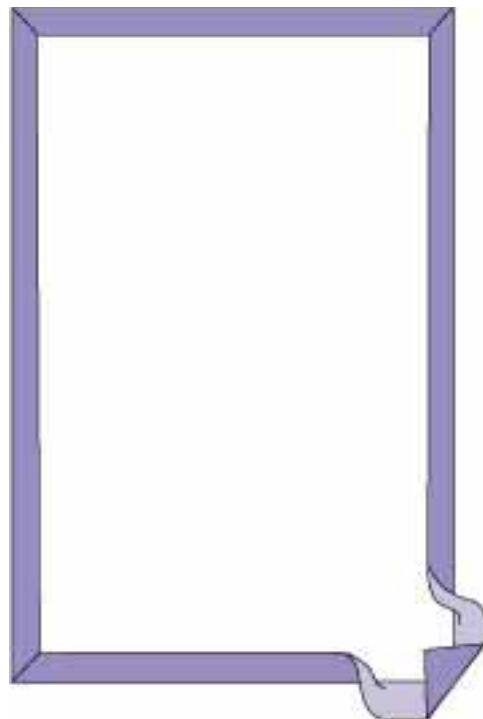
**NOTIONS:** One 20" x 30" piece of foam core board. One 24" x 34" piece of batting. Five yards of 5/8" ribbon. Eight 5/8" buttons. Masking tape, glue, thread, and hand sewing needle.

**INSTRUCTIONS:**

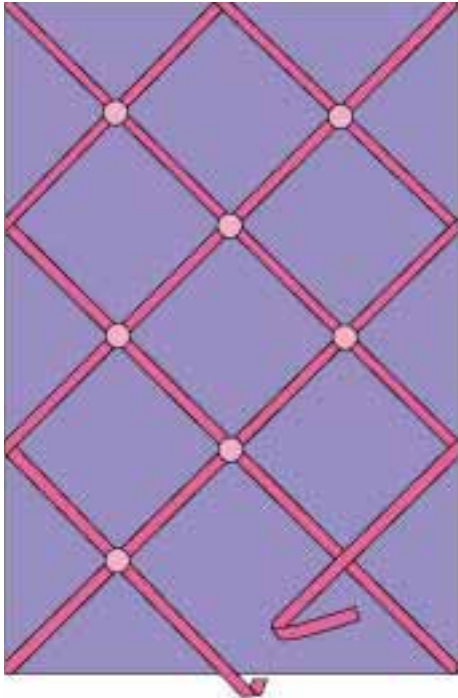
1. Center the batting over the wrong side of the fabric. Baste the batting to the fabric.



2. Center the foam core over the wrong side of the fabric/batting. Fold the edges of the fabric around the foam core, folding in fullness at corners. Tape or glue the raw edges in place.



3. Position the ribbon as shown below, working from left to right, extending ends 1-1/2" beyond edges. Tape or glue ends in place. Working from right to left, apply the remaining ribbon to board in same manner. Glue ribbon to fabric at intersecting points. Glue buttons to ribbon.



4. Start posting your memories!
